## **Pique Assiette Mosaic Workshop Supplies List**

### **Materials you will need:**

We supply the adhesives and grout for all workshops.

Students will supply their own tile, stained glass, china, broken pottery and other objects for their project(s). Old game pieces and letter tiles help personalize your piece. Old chipped china is ideal. A visit to the local hardware or home supply store might yield tile remnants or obsolete tile sample books. Pieces of stained glass add exciting elements to any project. Make sure to bring an ample supply.

A project to work on – suggestions: picture frames, clay or ceramic pots, birdhouses, boxes. If using wood, we advise that this not be a piece intended to be placed outdoors. Wood should be sealed with a sealer, or with a coat of flat latex paint.

### **Supplies and tools:**

All of these supplies can be acquired at your local Home Depot, Lowes or ACE Hardware.

- Plastic one gallon bucket for mixing grout – usually found in paint aisle
- Spoon, paddle or spatula to mix grout/mortar
- Hammer
- Glass cutter – if you are using stained glass or mirror
- Running pliers – for glass and mirror
- Tile Nippers or Wheeled Glass Nippers for tile and pottery
- Lots of Rags – such as tee shirts, old towels
- Large sponges
- Work gloves for handling glass
- Kitchen gloves for handling grout
